Host Hotel Information

The host hotel is the Embassy Suites Frisco: 7600 John Q Hammons Dr. Frisco, TX 75034. The Embassy Suites will also host the banquet on Sunday morning. If we run out of rooms, an alternate option is the Drury Inn and Suites which is a significant walk "across the parking lot" from the Embassy Suites. Frisco is about a 25-minute drive from either the Dallas-Ft. Worth International Airport or Dallas Love Field. The hotel is about 4 miles from the Frisco Campus of Collin College. **You can book your rooms at the Embassy Suites** over the phone or on-line. Families, administrators, teachers, and other guests are offered the same rates; however, all room reservations will need to be made directly with the hotel by **February 5, 2024**.

Registration Forms & Information

Registration before Competition

Please note that all credentials and team lists must be sent to **Rick Hopkins** by **February 1**, **2024**. We recommend using an overnight express mail service to ensure your documents arrive by the due date.

All coaches should plan to arrive at the hotel Thursday evening or Friday morning for registration. Registration will be open from 6pm to 8pm Thursday evening and from 9am to 10:30 am on Friday. The registration table will be in the hallway of the Conference Center attached to the hotel. Teams should plan to arrive at Collin College by 11:30 a.m., Friday. The first event of the competition, the Art test, will begin at 12:00 pm in the Conference Center. The first Coach's Meeting will be Friday, February 23th at 1:20pm in room F 249 on campus.

Team Meals

No meals will be provided on Friday or Saturday. There are no dining options on Collin College Frisco campus during the times we will be there. Water and snacks will be available during the competition. There are dozens of restaurants within 10 minutes of the contest venue. Please plan for lunch Saturday off-campus.

Super Quiz

Super Quiz will be held at Lebanon Trail High School, which is just south of Collin College. We ask that at least one coach volunteer to serve as a proctor during the event.

We also ask that your team create and bring a poster with your school name and decoration to march in with. We will have some extra poster board at registration. Posters are limited to 3ft by 3ft and can be carried or placed on a stick.

Awards Banquet

The Awards Banquet will be held on Sunday, February 25, 2023, at 8:00 a.m. at the Embassy Suites hotel. Doors will open at 7:45 a.m. Up to 11 team tickets (9 students and 2 coaches) will be purchased for you by Texas Academic Decathlon.

Guest tickets for the Awards Banquet will cost \$35 per person. Guests who would prefer audience-style seating will be charged \$20 for non-table open seating (no food). No one will be let into the banquet venue without a ticket of some kind. <u>All guest and observation tickets</u> <u>MUST be ordered through the school so the coach can keep track of those attending.</u>

Awards Banquet are on a first come-first served basis. There will be **NO** refunds after February 21, 2024. Guest banquet tickets will be numbered for seating at specific tables based on team affiliation. Tickets purchased after February 21st may not be seated near their group. If there are seats remaining, tickets may be available for cash-only purchase at the door.

Banquet presenters will receive a complementary guest ticket but must provide his or her own hotel accommodations if necessary. These attendees will be recognized and then assist in handing out the medals during the ceremony. Please complete the Awards Banquet Presenter form if your administrator is interested and include his or her title.

Vegetarian meals need to be arranged in advance. Please indicate the number requested on the ticket form for both team members and guests. Special vegetarian meal cards will be included with your tickets. Attendees will use the card to inform the servers.

Appropriate attire for this event would be the same as your students wore for the interview/speech events. Please remember there are school administrators, Texas and USAD board members, and parents present.

Transportation

We are unable to provide transportation for teams to any venues.

Team Rooms

Unfortunately, Collin College does not have the facilities to allow for team rooms. Unused classrooms surrounding our event will be locked and all teams will be asked to find a spot in the hallways of the Conference Center or the J Building to set up camp. Campus Facilitators will be around to help locate the necessary seating and help you be as comfortable as possible. Feel free to bring tent chairs if you would like.

Coaches Meetings & Hospitality Room

All coaches' meetings, whether at Collin College or at the Embassy Suites Hotel, are currently being scheduled for rooms that have a capacity of close to 90 people. We therefore require that a maximum of 2 coaches or representatives of each team attend the various coaches' meetings. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Snacks and drinks will be available in the J building on Friday and Saturday during the competition. You're welcome to use this room to relax or find volunteers if you need assistance during the meet.

Payment Information

We are only able to accept checks and credit cards for payment. **The only items you will pay the Collin College coordinator for are guest or observer banquet tickets.** *You will be purchasing through the hotel, T-shirt vendor, and the photographer directly.*

The checks can ONLY be from the schools, the district, or a coach. They need to be made out to Collin College and received by us by February 18th.

Dress Code & Code of Conduct

Student Dress Code

The following student dress code will apply to all Texas Academic Decathlon contests. Team uniforms for both boys and girls are optional.

Boys: Shirt and slacks; preferably a suit. Girls: Dress, suit, skirt/slacks and blouse.

Distracting apparel, including hats or any kind (except those worn for religious reasons), excessively baggy, torn or ragged denim and/or jeans, shall be considered inappropriate. If a test proctor, meet official, or coach observes violations of the dress code, the student should be given the opportunity to comply with the dress code prior to competition in an event. Once a student has been allowed to compete in an event, he or she may NOT be disqualified because of dress code violations.

Failure to comply with dress standards may result in disqualification from the event, the entire competition, and/or the awards' ceremony. The decision of the competition coordinator is final.

Code of Student Conduct

The Texas Academic Decathlon competition expects all team members to conduct themselves in a proper manner while attending the Texas Academic Decathlon event. This includes all of the travel, hotel, and sightseeing associated with their participation in the event.

Appropriate conduct of team members is the sole responsibility of the team coach/school administrator who has the legal responsibility of chaperone for his/her team members at all times. Students should be under the supervision of the coach/school administrator during all activities.

Inappropriate conduct includes but is not limited to:

- 1. Being in possession of any weapon
- 2. Damage to or vandalism of any property
- 3. Appropriation of memorabilia from the competition site premises
- 4. Use of alcohol or illegal drugs by students regardless of age
- 5. Use of water pistols, water balloons or other creative missiles at the competition site
- 6. Fighting, loud noise, or any other behavior which is disruptive to others at the competition site

Financial liability for all damage incurred by actions of a team member shall be the sole responsibility of that team member and his/her parents. Failure to comply with the Code of Student Conduct may result in disqualification from the event, the entire competition, and the awards ceremony.

In case of any incident, the Executive Director of the Texas Academic Decathlon shall convene a panel of three board members to discuss the matter and determine the appropriate action. Appropriate action may include individual and/or team disqualification.

Congratulations on making the State Finals! Team Photos will once again be offered by Kelling Photography. The photos will be taken on Friday during the Speech and Interview times. You will be scheduled so that the photo times will not interfere with your competition times. IF the time that you are assigned does not work for you, please stop by the photo area and we will be glad to find a time slot that is convenient.

You and your students may place their orders prior to the state meet by mail, during your photo time on Friday, or Sunday morning at the awards ceremony. The photos will be on display for students and parents to see prior to and after the awards ceremony.

An order form is included in this packet. Please print and distribute it to your students so that they and their parents can have the opportunity to order if they wish.

PLEASE NOTE: **SHIPPING COSTS** to deliver the plaques and photos to the school is the MAIN REASON prices have had to be raised!!! This is why combining orders and purchasing a Plaque Team Pack or a Photo Team Pack is more economical for all of us. Since all orders are shipped to the schools at once, orders received after March 15 will have an additional \$25/plaque added for shipping. <u>PLEASE</u> have all orders submitted by March 15.

Photo orders should be sent directly to Kelling Photograph. You can submit the orders prior to the meet or the orders can be placed on Friday as we take the team photos as well as at the awards banquet on Sunday morning.

TEXAS ACADEMIC DECATHLON Frisco State Finals Competition



All teams participating in the Academic Decathlon meet will have a picture made of their team with coaches. These pictures will be used for publicity purposes and also as a memento to participants.

Plaques and photos may be purchased by the school or by individuals. **Small Plaques** are 8 X 10 in size and will have a 5 X 7 photo mounted under acrylic. At the bottom is a plate stating team and members' names as well as the Decathlon logo. The cost of the Small Plaque is \$55. The **Large Plaque** is 11 X 17 in size with an 8 X 10 photo and is \$80.

Photos will be 5 X 7 in size and will be enclosed in a protective folder that will also serve as a frame and stand for the photo. Cost of the photo and folder is \$25.

Orders placed after March 15 will be \$30 for the unmounted photo and \$75 for the Small Plaque and require a \$25 shipping fee.

Schools may purchase a **"Plaque Team Pack"** for \$575. This includes 12 Small Plaques: one for each team member, one for each of two coaches, and one for the school. Or you may purchase a **"Photo Team Pack"** for \$325. This includes 11 Photos and one Small Plaque: one photo for each team member, one photo for each of two coaches, and one Small

Plague for the school. A school check is required for these options.

Orders may be mailed prior to the meet and will also be accepted at the meet. Photos and plaques will be mailed to the schools within eight weeks.
